Moved/seconded that the agenda is adopted as amended to place the Cobble Hill Event Society delegation as the first item of business. Carried

<u>Delegation</u> from the Cobble Hill Event Society: Wade Pendlebury outlined the events to be held in the Common beginning Thursday evening, June 5th. Close neighbours are enthusiastic, with the only concern being parking. Advertizing is on line and 20 volunteers are required.

Business arising from the minutes

- Horse Trailer Parking: Eye level "Horse Trailer Parking Only" signs to be installed
- Boatswain Park: Work is scheduled to begin Monday, April 11th with a completion date of June 1st.
- Cherry Point Park: New stairs have been installed and the parking lot graded. This is a very popular spot for visitors to enjoy the beach.
- Overall Plan for Cobble Hill Common: The Commission encourages preliminary overall planning and drawings.
- Disposal of Properties: Ongoing discussions continue with the adjacent landowner regarding Ross Park. Fisher Road Park is still under consideration by School District 79.
- Memorial Bench Policy: No clear direction as yet. Many considerations remain.
- Syrian Family: The Akil family has moved into the house in Satellite Park with the assistance of the Satellite Park Ratepayers Association
- QNP Parking: Moved/seconded that due to the regional use of Quarry Nature Park, our representation on the South Cowichan Parks Commission will present the case for financial assistance from the South Cowichan Parks budget. Carried
