## **COWICHAN VALLEY TRAIL | Regional Trail**

The Cowichan Valley Trail is a spectacular multi-use trail that is an integral part of the Trans Canada Trail route on Southern Vancouver Island. The majority of the gravel trail is wide and flat, with some sections running along the roadways. The trail provides for easy cycling and walking.



## STONEY HILL | Regional Park 8350 Stoney Hill Road, North Cowichan

Stoney Hill Regional Park has spectacular views of Salt Spring Island and the surrounding area with a looped trail of approximately 3.2 km. Stoney Hill Road leads off Genoa Bay Road to the parking lot/trailhead, which holds up to 25 vehicles.



## BRIGHT ANGEL PARK | Sub-Regional Park

2643 Riverfield Road, Cowichan Station

Located in Cowichan Station, Bright Angel Park features forested trails and Cowichan Valley's most popular suspension bridge. Contact the CVRD to book the group picnic shelters.



## SANDY POOL | Regional Park

4950 W Riverbottom Road, Duncan

Sandy Pool Regional Park is well-known for its sandy beach and great swimming in the Cowichan River. This park has over a kilometre of walking trails that lead through the forest with interpretive signage. The park is a destination for tubing and is a popular swimming spot.





## **COWICHAN BAY BOAT LAUNCH |** Area D

1865 Cowichan Bay Road, Cowichan Bay

The Cowichan Bay Boat Launch is the only public boat launch located between Mill Bay and North Cowichan. The 2.31 hectare park is situated beside Hecate Park, and provides boat trailer parking. An easy waterfront walking trail wraps around the northeast side.



#### **COBBLE HILL MOUNTAIN |** Regional Area 3500 Empress Avenue, Cobble Hill

Cobble Hill Mountain Regional Recreation Area is a popular destination for hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking. The Recreation Area is made up of 26 km of signed trails ranging in difficulty. Main access to Cobble Hill Mountain Regional Recreation Area is through

Quarry Nature Park.



#### **SOUTH COWICHAN DOG PARK |** Area C 3500 Empress Avenue, Cobble Hill

The South Cowichan Off-Leash Dog Park is located in Cobble Hill at the base of Cobble Hill Mountain. It is located in Quarry Nature Park and situated adjacent to Cleasby Bike Park.



## MILL BAY NATURE PARK | Area A 695 Hollings Road, Mill Bay

Mill Bay Nature Park was acquired in 1989. The park features walking trails, a viewing platform, picnic sites, and opportunities for beach walks and nature viewing.





## OLD MILL PARK | Area B

2500 Recreation Road, Shawnigan Lake

Old Mill Park is a waterfront park located on Shawnigan Lake. The park has an popular recreation place for families and nature enthusiasts.



## **HECATE PARK |** Area D

1865 Cowichan Bay Road, Cowichan Bay

Located in beautiful Cowichan Bay, Hecate Park is the jewel of the Bay. The park is located beside the Cowichan Bay Boat Launch, the Cowichan Estuary Nature Centre and the Cowichan Bay Marine Gateway.



# **CENTRAL PARK |** Area F

10022 Park Avenue, Honeymoon Bay

Central Park, located in the community of Honeymoon Bay, is adjacent to the Honeymoon Bay Community Ha and extends to the waterfront of Cowichan Lake.



## YELLOW POINT PARK | Area H

4151 Yellow Point Road, Yellow Point

The park offers loop trails and connections to Barney Road. The main trail is moderate in difficulty and is approximately 4 km in length. The Yellow Point Ecological Reserve to the north is not open to the public.

# KINSOL TRESTLE | Regional Trail 2869 Glen Eagles Road, Shawnigan Lake

## The Historic Kinsol Trestle is open to the public for cyclists, hikers and equestrians to experience crossing high above the Koksilah River. The Kinsol Trestle is one of eight trestles along the Cowichan Valley Trail section of the Trans Canada Trail.

### **QUARRY NATURE PARK |** Area C 3500 Empress Avenue, Cobble Hill

Quarry Nature Park is a highly popular spot in Cobble Hill that is home to both the South Cowichan Off-Leash Dog Park and Cleasby Bike Park. The trails within this park connect to the trails within Cobble Hill Mountain.



## GLENORA TRAILS HEAD PARK | Area E 4284 Robertson Road, Duncan

The Glenora Trails Head Park is an important eastern gateway to the Cowichan River Provincial Park, the central portion of the Cowichan Valley Trail (part of the Trans Canada Trail), the Cowichan River Footpath and Glenora Riverside Park.



## SALTAIR CENTENNIAL PARK | Area G 3850 South Oyster School Road, Saltair

This large, multi-sport community park


in Saltair offers a ball field, picnic shelter, playground, sports court and tennis court.
