Woodstove Replacement Program

This woodstove replacement rebate program is coordinated by the Cowichan Valley Regional District (CVRD) and is open to all residents in the Cowichan Valley. Woodstove Replacement Program rebates are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

This program allows you to replace your smoky, old woodstove with a more efficient and healthier heating appliance, like a heat pump, gas stove, pellet stove or an EPA-certified woodstove.

A \$550 rebate (plus \$50 retailer discount) is available for replacing an old woodstove with a heat pump, Enerchoice gas stove or an EPA-certified pellet stove.

A \$300 rebate (plus \$50 retailer discount) is available for replacing an old woodstove with a new, EPA-certified woodstove.

Conditions:

- Only one rebate per taxable residence per year.
- A second-hand heating appliance does not qualify as a replacement appliance.
- The value of the rebate must not exceed the value of the new heating appliance.
- Rebate tracking numbers will only be issued to residents not purchasing from a participating retailer upon the purchase of the new heating appliance.
- Both the old woodstove and the new heating appliance must meet the rebate program requirements. Visit cvrld.bc.ca/woodstove for more details.

To Receive the Rebate:

- The old woodstove must be inspected by a Wood Energy Technical Training (WETT) certified technician to certify the age of the old woodstove.
- If you are replacing an old wood burning appliance with a new wood burning appliance, the WETT certified technician must certify that the new appliance and chimney meet current WETT and CSA standards.

Note: You are responsible for obtaining the appropriate building permit required for installation of a new wood burning appliance.

STEP 1: Qualification

To qualify, the appliance being replaced must be:

- presently used as the primary heating source.
- manufactured prior to November 1, 1994. (A WETT certified technician such as your retailer or chimney sweep can assist you in verifying the age of your appliance).

STEP 2: Retailer Discount and Installation

Choose your new heating appliance. Contact one of the participating retailers (listed on the right) to arrange purchase. Once rebate eligibility is verified, the retailer will provide you with you a minimum \$50 discount upon purchase (this is in addition to the CVRD rebate). The retailer will also provide a tracking number that will secure your rebate with the CVRD. This tracking number will be used to verify the purchase and installation of your new heating appliance, as well as verify the recycling of your old woodstove. The retailer will assist you with your rebate application.

If you do NOT elect to purchase from a participating retailer, you must provide a copy of your purchase receipt to the CVRD before you will be issued a tracking number.

Before installation of the new heating appliance, ensure that the old woodstove is inspected by a WETT certified technician and certified to have been manufactured before November 1, 1994.

STEP 3: Disposal of Old Woodstove

To improve Cowichan Valley air quality, to prevent old woodstoves from being reused by someone else and to ensure proper recycling, old woodstoves must be permanently disabled before being dropped off at a CVRD Recycling Centre (Bings Creek, Peerless Road or Meade Creek Recycling Centre) and **signed off by a CVRD Recycling Attendant:**

- Doors removed and door hinges bludgeoned
- Ash and brick liner removed
- Flue collar bludgeoned

STEP 4: Submit Application

Make sure you provide:

- A copy of purchase receipt
- A copy of WETT inspection report
- Both sides of this brochure completed
- A photo of the new, properly installed appliance

Please ensure that this application is completed in full and that all requested supporting documents are attached. The CVRD will mail you a rebate cheque within six weeks of receiving your application. **The deadline for submitting your application is ten (10) weeks following the date of purchase. Applications received after ten (10) weeks will not be considered.**
